

## Liz Skitch: The Harvest

Performing artist, Liz Skitch, created an online version of her interactive performance art project, 'The Harvest' (created for Thomastown Neighbourhood House's "Tastes of Thommo" Festival in 2019). Liz will play "Mother Nature" in all her colourful 70's Mumu - glory, wearing a garland of flowers around a wig of golden curls that fall to the ground. This online experience will take the form of approximately 5 x 5 minute, edited mini docs, hosted by "Mother Nature".

Each mini doc featured an interview with a resident from Liz's neighbourhood, who took the audience either into their kitchen to share a favourite recipe or into their garden to explore fruit trees, grape vines, chook pens or vegie patches.
