

Community art installation Burrows

Marveloo Mobile Accessible Restroom

Marveloo is a modified Changing Places toilet equipped with a ceiling hoist and an adult change table, specifically designed for individuals who require these facilities and cannot use a standard accessible toilet. Marveloo is a locked amenity requires a Master Locksmith Access Key (MLAK) to open the toilet. This key is necessary to unlock the facility.
